Term ends Friday 12th April. Back Monday 29th April

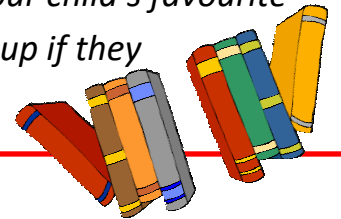


Visit to Farm.
